

KNOW all men by these presents, that we *James Solar*
David Whitford and
Elijah Callaway
are held and firmly bound unto *James Solar* Esquire
Chairman of the Court of Pleas and Quarter-Sessions, of the County aforesaid, in the
sum of *two hundred & fifty pounds*

current money; to be paid to said Chairman, his Successors or Assigns. To the which
payment well & truly to be made, we bind Ourselves, our Heirs, Executors and Ad-
ministrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents; sealed with our Seals,
and dated this *9th* day of *June* A. D. 181 *8*

THE condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bounden
James Solar
Administrat of all and singular the Goods and Chattels, rights & credits of
Jacob Solar deceased, do make,
or cause to be made, a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the Goods and
Chattels, rights & credits of the deceased, which have or shall come to the hands,
knowledge or possession of the said *James Solar*

or unto the hands or possession of any person or persons, for *him* and the
same so made, do exhibit or cause to be exhibited, to the Court of the County a-
foresaid, within ninety days from the date of these presents; and the same Goods,
Chattels and Credits, and all the other Goods, Chattels and Credits of the decea-
sed, at the time of his death, which at any time hereafter shall come into the hands
or possession of the said *James Solar*

or into the hands or possession of any person or persons, for *him* do well
& truly Administer according to Law, and further do make or cause to be made a
true and just account of *his* said Administration within *two years*
after the date of these presents, and all the rest and residue of the said Goods,
Chattels & Credits which shall be found remaining upon the said Administrat^{or's}
account, the same being first examined and allowed by the Court of said County,
shall deliver and pay unto such person or persons, respectively, to which the same
shall be due, pursuant to the true intent and meaning of the Act in that case made
and provided: and if it shall appear that any Will or Testament was made by the
said deceased, and the Execut^{or} therein named to exhibit the same into Court
making request to have the same allowed and approved accordingly:

If the said *James Solar*
above bounden, being thereunto required, do render the said letters of Administra-
tion (a probation of such Testament, being first had and made in the said Court)
then this obligation to be void and of no effect, otherwise to remain in full force &
virtue.

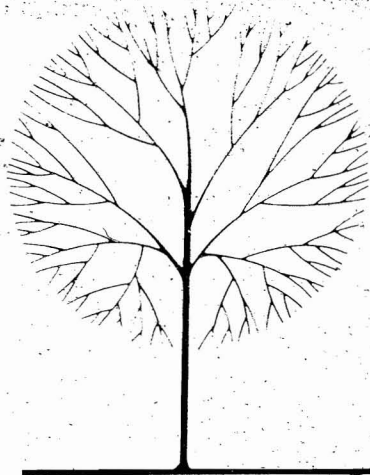
